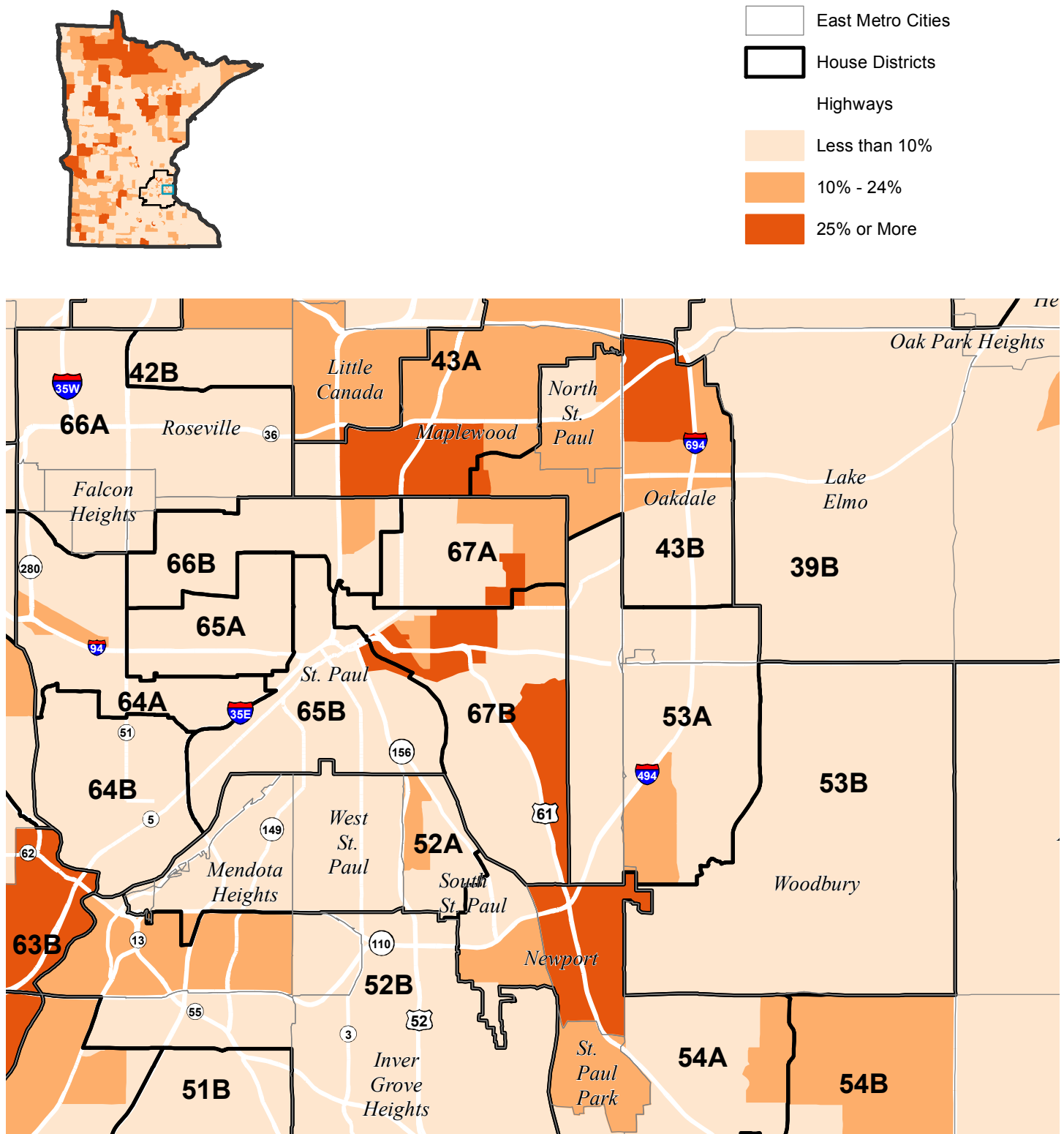


Share of Residents with Low Healthy Food Access Due to Income and Distance Barriers in the Twin Cities East Metro area
