



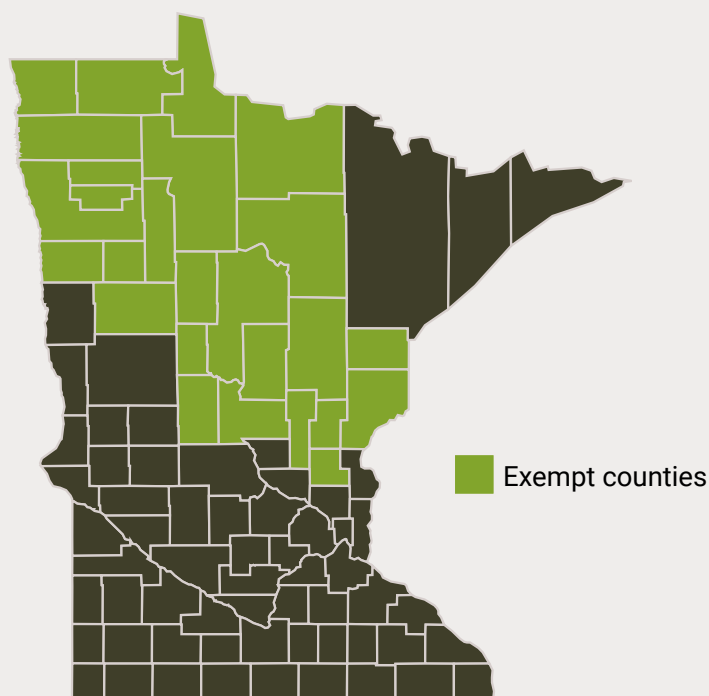
IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON SNAP ELIGIBILITY

Help your adult clients without kids access extra food this year!

We have good news for your clients ages 18 to 49 who do not have dependent children living with them. The waiver for time limits and work requirements for using SNAP have been extended for 26 counties and most Tribal Reservations in Minnesota for the year October 1, 2019 – September 30, 2020.

These counties & reservations are now exempt from the “3 months” time limit and work requirements for SNAP benefits. This means they can apply for SNAP and keep it through September 30, 2019 (It may be possible that the waiver will be extended).
